Threat Evaluation and Reporting Overview (Virtual)

The Threat Evaluation and Reporting Overview (TERO) is a three-hour introductory training focusing on a behavioral approach to violence prevention. The TERO raises awareness about the risk factors, triggers and stressors, and warning behaviors that could impact a person's decision to commit an act of targeted violence. Further, it outlines the mitigating factors that could help prevent acts of targeted violence, while emphasizing the importance of community involvement in seeking help for individuals, and respecting their privacy, civil rights, and civil liberties. Students who complete this program will receive a U.S. Department of Homeland Security certificate.

- Define Targeted Violence and Behavioral Threat Assessment and Management (BTAM)
- Identify the elements and purpose of the pathway to violence
- Outline the BTAM Model
- Understand Key Aspects of Community Involvement in BTAM
- Recognize Common Warning Signs and Concerning Behaviors
